
Unity @ 30 : Logo Release of 30th Anniversary Celebrations of the College


Onam celebration

Hindi Fortnight Celebration




Memorandum of Understanding signed with C.H.M.K.M. H.S.S Kavanur, Irivetty


Talk on 'What is at Home'


Association Programme


OZONE DAY CELEBRATION


Community Outreach Programme- Report Hand Wash Preparation Training Program


Weekly puzzle competition




