Department of English

Department of Botany

Community-Based Survey

A community-based survey named, "Sow, Grow, Eat" was conducted by the PG Department of Botany in Ward 47, Narukara, under the guidance of faculty coordinator, Nahla Zakariya, (Assistant Professor Adhoc). Upon analysis, it was found that most households surveyed do not have kitchen gardens due to constraints related to space and time. However, to encourage kitchen gardening, householders who did not have kitchen gardens were provided with seeds of amaranthus, tomato, lady's finger, and pea. The findings underscore the importance of promoting kitchen gardening initiatives within the community.



Inter-Departmental Alumni Talk
